

What Additional Information is Available on the e-Scorecard?

The e-Scorecard provides hospital-specific data for all of the indicators provided in the *Hospital Report 2007* series. In addition, hospitals can find the following information on the e-Scorecard:

- Sex-specific and sex-difference indicator results for Patient Satisfaction and Clinical Utilization and Outcomes.
- For most indicators, hospitals are able to ‘drill down’ to find more detailed information on the indicator scores.
- Where appropriate, hospitals are able to view their own site-level indicator values.
